THE STORY

Cephas Williams is a visionary, creative mind, and campaigner reshaping narratives and representation in the UK and beyond.

He originally pursued a career in architecture but in 2018 he shifted his focus to using space and storytelling for social change. He launched a creative co-working hub in South London before turning fully toward purpose-led work. In 2018, he launched the groundbreaking 56 Black Men campaign, a pioneering nationwide billboard campaign that challenged the negative stereotypes often placed on Black men, by highlighting the humanity and positive contributions of Black men across the UK.

In 2021, he unveiled Portrait of Black Britain, a first-of-its-kind public exhibition reframing perceptions of Black identity in the UK.

After the murder of George Floyd, Cephas wrote a powerful open letter to his newborn son, Letter to Zion. This became the foundation for The Black Network, an organisation working with more than 50 senior executives and industry leading organisations to tackle systemic racism and build a more equitable human experience for the Black community. Early supporters included Paul Polman (former global CEO of Unilever) and actor Simon Pegg, among others.



A sought-after speaker, Cephas has addressed audiences at TEDx, Google, Accenture's Global Leadership Conference, Cannes Lions, and more. He has convened over 60 hours of roundtable dialogue with 1,000+ participants, bridging grassroots voices with global leaders to spark real understanding and systemic change. His message is consistent and clear rooted in our shared humanity, focused on systemic change, and a commitment to exploring how we improve the experience of humanity.

When it comes to community and social impact, Cephas Williams has spent over a decade creating work that has reached millions, while directly transforming the lives of thousands.

Alongside his wider work, Cephas created 'Black Out,' through this work Cephas has broken down barriers to access, personally investing over £160,000 to support over 100 people across a variety of industries from the Black community in attending the festival and driving structural inclusion across the industry.

Cephas is recognised as a catalyst for systemic and cultural change. Yet he describes himself simply: human first, and above all, dad.

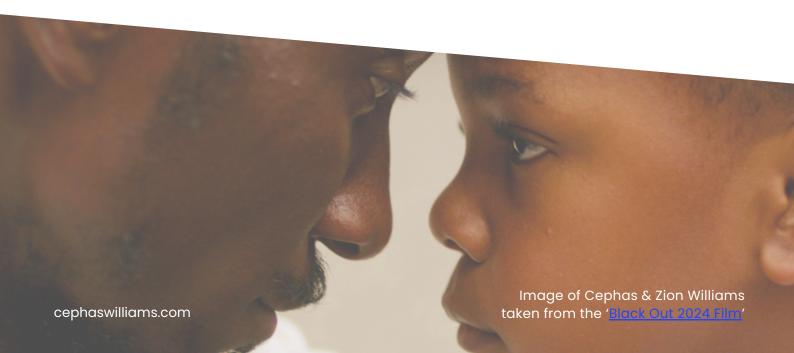

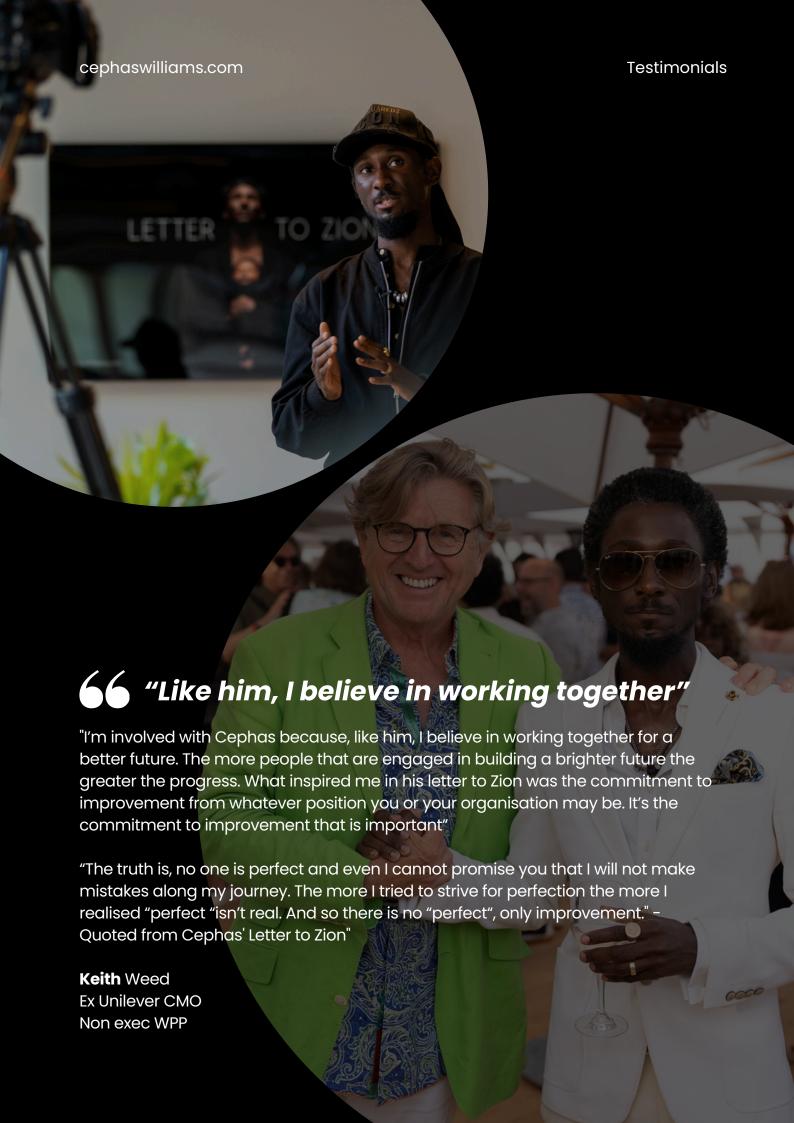

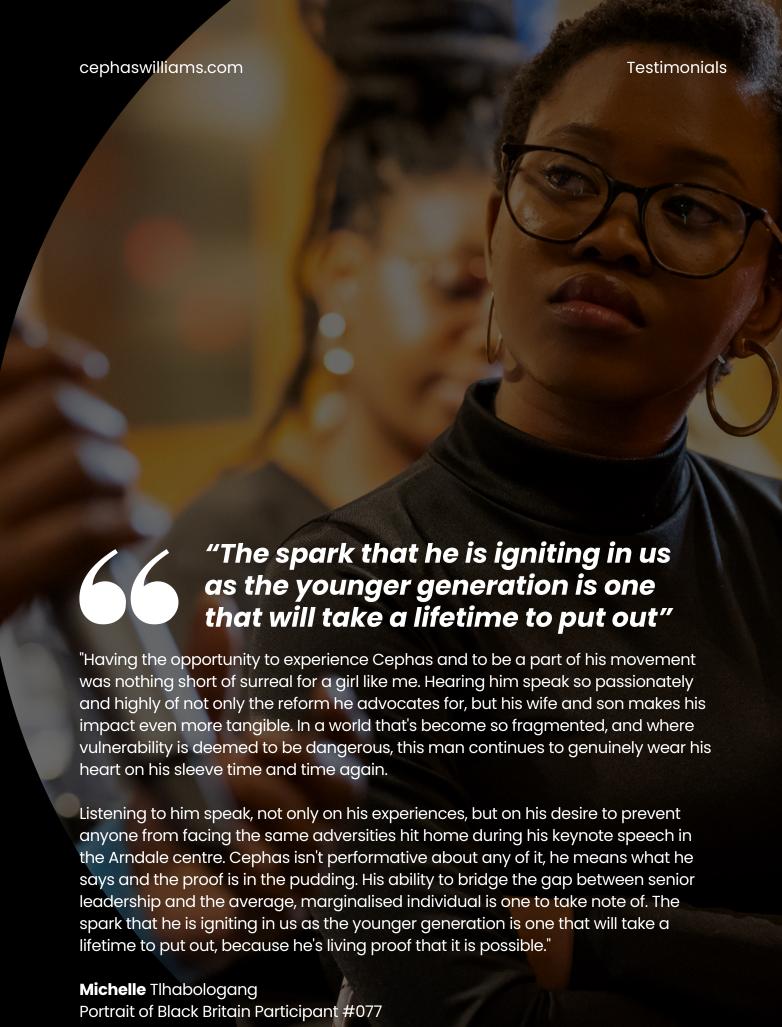
